First Communion class culminates with first communion on Palm Sunday. Congratulations and blessings for our young people who are receiving their first communion.




#### "The Theology of the Cross" Adult Forum Lenten Study

### What is Holy Week?

Holy Week is the climax of the Lenten season. It begins with Palm Sunday or Passion Sunday when the church remembers Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem as the people's savior. The story continues into Thursday when we remember Jesus' last supper that he shares with his disciples, the Passover meal where Jesus gives the church the sacrament of Holy Communion. And finally, Friday remembers Jesus' death on the cross and the suffering he took on himself for the sake of the world. Friday is the darkest day of the church year, but in three days, the Light will shine and the church will proclaim its most important proclamation,

"HE IS RISEN!"
